7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into a Local Public Agency agreement**  
8 **with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for the Ravenna Road**  
9 **Resurfacing Project, located in Council District 1, and the Canton Road Resurfacing**  
10 **Project, located in Council District 8, with the Department of Transportation providing up**  
11 **to a total of \$1,128,000.00 in Surface Transportation Block Grant funds, with the Engineer**  
12 **being responsible for the balance of the project costs, at a total cost not to exceed**  
13 **\$1,959,395.00, for the Executive and Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

14  
15 WHEREAS, the Engineer's Office has received Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation  
16 Study Surface Transportation Block Grant ("STBG") awards for the resurfacing of Ravenna  
17 Road from Old Mill Road to the Portage County line (Project Identification Number 113175)  
18 and the resurfacing of Canton Road from Pontius Road to Tisen Road (Project Identification  
19 Number 115358), herein referred to as (the "Projects"); and

20  
21 WHEREAS, the total cost of the Ravenna Road Resurfacing Project is estimated to be  
22 \$1,003,000.00 with STBG funds covering 80% of construction costs up to a maximum of  
23 \$600,000.00, and the Canton Road Resurfacing Project is estimated to be \$956,395.00 with  
24 STBG funds covering 80% of construction costs up to a maximum of \$528,000.00; and

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26 WHEREAS, the Engineer's Office is responsible to provide the remaining funds  
27 necessary for the Project costs; and

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29 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Transportation  
30 ("ODOT"), and the Executive and Engineer desire to enter into a Local Public Agency ("LPA")  
31 agreement, to confirm the Projects' costs and to designate the County of Summit as the lead  
32 agency for administration of the Projects; and

33  
34 WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as  
35 Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter allow execution of such LPA  
36 agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

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38 WHEREAS, said LPA Agreement will provide (i) that the estimated cost of the Projects  
39 is \$1,959,395.00, (ii) that ODOT shall provide to the County as the LPA up to 80% of eligible  
40 Project costs, in an amount not to exceed \$1,128,000.00 in total across the two Projects, and (iii)  
41 that the County, as the LPA, will provide the remaining funds necessary to pay for the Projects'  
42 costs; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, by reviewing all pertinent information, that it  
45 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
46 execute the aforementioned LPA agreement with ODOT;

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48 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
49 of Ohio, that:  
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4 SECTION 1

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6 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute Local Public Agency (“LPA”) agreements  
7 and any other necessary related documents with the State of Ohio, through the Department of  
8 Transportation (“ODOT”), for the Ravenna Road Resurfacing Project, Project Identification  
9 Number 113175, located in Council District 1, and the Canton Road Resurfacing Project, Project  
10 Identification Number 115358, located in Council District 8, copies of which are attached hereto  
11 as Exhibits A and B, respectively, and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and  
12 revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said LPA agreement and not substantially  
13 adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by  
14 the execution thereof by the Executive. Upon federal authorization from ODOT, the County may  
15 commence the administration of the Projects, with the award of the Projects subject to applicable  
16 Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, said Ordinances requiring authorization of such  
17 an award by the Board of Control and/or this Council.

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19 SECTION 2

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21 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
22 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately  
23 completes a prerequisite to accept funds needed for safe and convenient travel within the County.

25 SECTION 3

26  
27 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
28 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
29 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

31 SECTION 4

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33 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
34 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
35 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
36 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including  
37 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
