7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Davey Resource Group, Inc. for the evaluation and vegetation cleaning on**
9 **detention and retention ponds located within assessed Township subdivisions located in**
10 **Council Districts 1, 4, and 5, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term, for**
11 **an amount not to exceed \$95,000.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Engineer has determined that evaluation, planning, and performance of
14 various aquatic vegetation eradication, general maintenance, and adjunct services on an as-
15 needed basis at storm water management facilities (“SWMFs”) in Drainage Maintenance District
16 1 for various future County projects are needed for the welfare of the public; and

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18 WHEREAS, Drainage Maintenance District 1 includes the townships of Bath in Districts
19 4 and 5, Richfield, Boston, Sagamore Hills, Northfield Center, and Twinsburg in Council District
20 1; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Engineer sent out five requests for proposals and received three
23 submissions. After a review of the proposals, the Engineer recommended that the Executive
24 select Davey Resource Group, Inc. as the highest scoring and most qualified firm; and

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26 WHEREAS, Davey Resource Group, Inc. will perform all evaluation, planning, and
27 performance of various aquatic vegetation eradication, general maintenance, and adjunct services
28 as authorized by the Engineer at locations as specified among the 90 SWMFs in 66 assessed
29 subdivisions in Drainage Maintenance District 1; and

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31 WHEREAS, this project is funded by the Assessed Subdivision Fund for District 1 which
32 property owners in the assessed subdivisions pay into this fund for the perpetual maintenance of
33 stormwater facilities located within the subdivisions; and

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35 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 3, 2023, awarded a
36 professional service contract with Davey Resource Group, Inc. for the evaluation and vegetation
37 cleaning on detention and retention ponds located within assessed Township subdivisions located
38 in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term, for an
39 amount not to exceed \$95,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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41 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
42 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Davey Resource Group, Inc. is
43 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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45 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
46 of Ohio, that:

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48 SECTION 1

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50 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Davey
51 Resource Group, Inc. for the evaluation and vegetation cleaning on detention and retention ponds
52 located within assessed Township subdivisions located in the Council Districts 1, 4, and 5 with

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6 two options to renew for an additional one-year term, for an amount not to exceed \$95,000.00, is
7 hereby confirmed, and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service
8 contract and any other necessary related documents.

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10 SECTION 2

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12 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
13 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will allow the
14 Engineer's project to commence as expeditiously as possible.

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16 SECTION 3

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18 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
19 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
20 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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22 SECTION 4

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24 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
25 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
26 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
27 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
28 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
