7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **American Roadway Logistics for the 2023 Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an**
9 **amount not to exceed \$280,031.20, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2022-370, which authorized
12 the Executive to advertise for bridge engineering and construction projects, and pavement
13 maintenance projects, for the Engineer’s 2023 Capital Improvements Program, for an estimated
14 cost not to exceed \$13,962,800.00; and

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16 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program
17 for 2023-2028 by Resolution No. 2023-025; and

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19 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive proposes entering
20 into a construction contract with American Roadway Logistics, as the lowest responsive and
21 responsible bidder, for the 2023 Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an amount not to
22 exceed \$280,031.20; and

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24 WHEREAS, the work to be performed by American Roadway Logistics will be applying
25 pavement marking paint to various County, City of New Franklin and Sagamore Hills Township
26 roads; and

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28 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows
29 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying the contractor:

- 30 County share: \$247,102.00
- 31 New Franklin: \$37,280.70
- 32 Sagamore Hills Township: \$5,125.50; and

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35 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on May 10, 2023, awarded a
36 construction contract with American Roadway Logistics, as the lowest responsive and
37 responsible bidder, for the 2023 Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an amount not to
38 exceed \$280,031.20, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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40 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
41 that the aforementioned construction contract with American Roadway Logistics for the 2023
42 Regional Pavement Marking Program is necessary and in the best interest of the County of
43 Summit;

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with American Roadway
7 Logistics for the 2023 Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an amount not to exceed
8 \$280,031.20 is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
9 construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

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11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
14 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
15 provide necessary pavement marking to various County, City of New Franklin and Sagamore
16 Hills Township roads in 2023.

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18 SECTION 3

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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24 SECTION 4

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
29 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
30 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
