7 **A Resolution determining to proceed with the submission to the voters of the County the**
8 **question of the replacement of an existing tax levy for the programs and services of the**
9 **Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board (the “SCDDB”), and declaring an**
10 **emergency.**

12 BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

14 SECTION 1

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16 This Council makes the following findings and determinations:

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18 (a) On May 1, 2023, this Council adopted Resolution No. 2023-135 (the “Resolution
19 of Necessity”) declaring the necessity of submitting to the voters of the County
20 the question of a tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of the
21 replacement of an existing 4.50 mill tax levy (the “Tax Levy”) for the programs
22 and services of the Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board (the
23 “SCDDB”).

24 (b) The Fiscal Officer has certified to this Council the total current tax valuation of
25 the County \$ and that the 4.50 mills per each dollar of tax valuation specified in
26 the Resolution of Necessity will generate \$66,121,000 of revenue per year in
27 accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code.

28 (c) This Council has received the report of the Social Services Advisory Board (the
29 “SSAB”) in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity approving the Tax Levy
30 request and proposal of the SCDDB.

31 (d) This Council determines to proceed with the submission of the question of the
32 Tax Levy to the voters of the entire territory of the County at the November 7,
33 2023 general election.

34 (e) All formal actions of this Council relating to the enactment of this Resolution
35 were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this
36 Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions, were in
37 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including
38 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

40 SECTION 2

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42 This Council authorizes and directs the Clerk of Council to deliver to the Board of
43 Elections of Summit County a certified copy of this Resolution, a certified copy of the
44 Resolution of Necessity, and the Fiscal Officer’s certificate no later than August 9, 2023, the
45 90th day before the November 7, 2023 general election.

58 A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

59 A replacement of an existing tax for the benefit of the Summit County
60 Developmental Disabilities Board for the purpose of providing community
61 developmental disabilities programs and services pursuant to Chapter 5126 of the
62 Revised Code for the benefit of children and adults, that the County Fiscal Officer
63 estimates will collect \$66,121,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 4.50 mills for
64 each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$158, rounded to the nearest dollar,
65 for each \$100,000 of the County Fiscal Officer’s appraised value, for a period of 6
66 years, commencing in 2024, first due in calendar year 2025.

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71 This Resolution hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
72 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that this Resolution is
73 required to be immediately effective to submit the question of the Tax Levy to the voters of the
74 entire territory of the County by the deadline for the November 7, 2023 general election.

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78 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it will take
79 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it will take effect
80 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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84 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
85 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
86 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action
87 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
88 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
