7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into a Local Public Agency agreement with**
8 **the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for the Snyder Road Bridge**
9 **over Tuscarawas River Replacement Project, located in the City of Barberton, in Council**
10 **District 7, for an estimated total cost of \$1,841,250.00, with the Department of**
11 **Transportation providing County Engineer’s Association of Ohio Local Bridge Program**
12 **funds to cover 100% of the project costs, with no local cash match required, and for the**
13 **East Steels Corners Bridge over Mud Brook Rehabilitation Project, located in the City of**
14 **Stow, in Council District 3, for an estimated cost of \$1,188,000.00, with the Department of**
15 **Transportation providing Local Major Bridge Program funds and Bridge Credit**
16 **Partnership funds, covering up to 95% of project costs, with the local match of 5%**
17 **required, for the Executive and Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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19 WHEREAS, the Engineer’s Office applied for and received County Engineer’s
20 Association of Ohio Local Bridge Program grant funding for the replacement of the Snyder Road
21 Bridge over the Tuscarawas River, located in the City of Barberton, in Council District 7, Project
22 Identification Number 117489, and applied for and received Local Major Bridge Program and
23 Bridge Credit Program grant funds for the East Steels Corners Road over Mud Brook
24 Rehabilitation Project, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, Project Identification
25 Number 118730 (“the Projects”); and

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27 WHEREAS, the Engineer, as an authorized Local Public Agency for the Ohio
28 Department of Transportation’s Local Let Process, will administrator the Projects; and

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30 WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of the Project is \$3,029,250.00; and

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32 WHEREAS, federal funding programmed through the County Engineer’s Association of
33 Ohio Local Bridge Program has been awarded to the Engineer’s Office for a grant to cover 100%
34 of the Snyder Road Bridge over the Tuscarawas Replacement costs, in an amount not to exceed
35 \$1,841,250.00, with the Engineer being responsible for any remaining costs of Project over
36 \$1,841,250.00; and

38 WHEREAS, state funding programmed through the Ohio Department of Transportation’s
39 Local Major Bridge Program and Toll Revenue Credit Program has been awarded to the
40 Engineer’s office for grants to cover up to 95% of the East Steels Corners Road Bridge over Mud
41 Brook Rehabilitation Project, up to a maximum of \$1,128,00.00, with the Engineer being
42 responsible for 5% of the project costs, in an estimated amount of \$59,400.00; and

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44 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Transportation
45 (“ODOT”), and the Engineer desire to enter into a Local Public Agency (“LPA”) agreement, to
46 confirm the Projects’ costs and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for
47 administration of the Projects; and

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49 WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as
50 Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter allow execution of such LPA
51 agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

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4 WHEREAS, said LPA Agreement will provide (i) that the estimated cost of the Projects
5 is \$3,029,250.00.00, (ii) that ODOT shall provide to the County as the LPA 100% of eligible
6 Project costs, in an amount not to exceed \$1,841,250.00 in Federal Highway Administration
7 funds for the Snyder Road Bridge over the Tuscarawas River Replacement Project and that
8 ODOT shall provide to the County as the LPA 95% of eligible Project costs in an amount not to
9 exceed \$1,128,600.00 for the East Steels Corners Road Bridge over Mud Brook Rehabilitation
10 Project, and (iii) that the County, as the LPA, will provide the remaining funds necessary to pay
11 for the Project costs; and

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13 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, by reviewing all pertinent information, that it
14 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
15 execute the aforementioned LPA agreement with ODOT;

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17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
18 of Ohio, that:

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20 SECTION 1

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22 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Local Public Agency (“LPA”) agreement
23 with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation (“ODOT”), for the replacement
24 of the Snyder Road Bridge over Tuscarawas River, Project Identification Number 117489 and
25 for the rehabilitation of the East Steels Corners Road Bridge over Mud Brook, Project
26 Identification Number 118730 (“the Projects”), copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibit A
27 and Exhibit B and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in
28 furtherance of the provisions of said LPA agreement and not substantially adverse to the County,
29 all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the execution thereof by
30 the Executive. Upon federal authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the
31 administration of the Project, with the award of the Project subject to applicable Codified
32 Ordinances of the County of Summit, said Ordinances requiring authorization of such an award
33 by the Board of Control and/or County Council.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
39 completes a prerequisite to accept funds needed for a bridge replacement project in Summit
40 County.

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42 SECTION 3

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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4 SECTION 4

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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
9 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
