8 **contract with Richard D. Reinbold, Esq., to provide services as Interim Director of the**
9 **Office of Backlog Reduction, from 5/22/23 through 12/31/24, in an amount not to exceed**
10 **\$169,840.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

13 Whereas, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division wishes to establish an Office of
14 Backlog Reduction in the focused on reducing the backlog of criminal cases pending before the
15 Court; and

17 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, wishes to enter into a
18 professional service contract with Richard D. Reinbold, Esq., to provide services as Interim
19 Director of the Office of Backlog Reduction, from 5/22/23 through 12/31/24, in an amount not to
20 exceed \$169,840.00, to be funded by an American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) grant from the Ohio
21 Office of Criminal Justice Services to the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, for backlog
22 reduction; and

24 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 31, 2023, awarded said
25 professional service contract with Richard D. Reinbold, Esq., from 5/22/23 through 12/31/24, in
26 an amount not to exceed \$169,840.00, subject to confirmation by Council; and

28 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
29 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Richard D. Reinbold, Esq. is
30 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

41 necessary related documents.
