7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a contract with Clarity**
8 **Solutions Group, LLC, subject to the approval of the Information Technology Board, for**
9 **services to automate the processing of Medicaid renewal packets received by mail, in an**
10 **amount not to exceed \$211,615.00, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family**
11 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, at the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, Congress enacted the Families First
14 Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA), which allowed people to be continuously enrolled in
15 Medicaid programs through the end of the COVID-19 public health emergency, and as part of
16 the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023, Congress delinked the continuous enrollment
17 provision, ending continuous enrollment on March 31, 2023; and

18
19 WHEREAS, in order to process the high volume of mail coming to the Executive’s
20 Department of Job and Family Services as a result of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023,
21 said Department, utilizing its Shared Cost Pool Funds, desires to enter into a contract with
22 Clarity Solutions Group, LLC for services to automate the processing of Medicaid renewal
23 packets received by mail; and

25 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on June 21, 2023, awarded a
26 contract to Clarity Solutions Group, LLC, subject to confirmation by Council and the approval of
27 the Information Technology Board, for the above-referenced services; and

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29 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Board, at its meeting to be held July 13, 2023,
30 will consider the aforementioned purchase contract with Clarity Solutions Group, LLC, for
31 approval; and

33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
34 that the aforementioned contract with Clarity Solutions Group, LLC, for the above-referenced
35 services is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
