WHEREAS, the County wishes to contribute \$250,000.00 to the State of Ohio to serve as a portion of the matching funds required under the Agreement to assist in the removal of the Gorge Dam; and

WHEREAS, Section 307.77 of the Ohio Revised Code permits a county to give aid to any unit of government, including state and federal, that is for a public improvement project, including projects that will alleviate pollution or for the betterment of sanitary conditions, and the general public benefit to the county is in an amount corresponding with or greater than the amount of aid which the county will contribute; and

WHEREAS, the County finds and determines that the improvement will be for the general public benefit and determines the public benefit to the county is corresponding with or greater than the amount of aid which the county will contribute; and

 WHEREAS, upon receipt of the funds, the Ohio EPA will place the contribution in the fund established pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.016 and, upon approval, will transfer the full amount of \$250,000.00 to the US EPA as a contribution towards the non-federal sponsor share as set forth in the Agreement by the date set forth in the Agreement; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

This Council hereby authorizes the Executive to execute a contribution agreement with Ohio EPA to provide funds, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00, to support the removal of the Gorge Dam, a part of the Remedial Design of the Cuyahoga River Gorge Dam Great Lakes Legacy Act Contaminated Sediment Project.

SECTION 2

 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that the County wishes to authorize the Executive to execute a contribution agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
