A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute, subject to approval by the Board of Control, Change Order No. 1 to increase the purchase of NET services for calendar year 2023 for various vendors, as set forth in Exhibit A, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Job and Family Service ("DJFS") coordinates and monitors NET services for eligible Summit County Medicaid clients through NET providers via portal-to-portal transportation, which is funded by federal pass-through Medicaid dollars; and

WHEREAS, NET provides state mandated transportation services for Medicaid eligible Summit County residents to medical appointments, both in and out of the county, for critical services, such as, renal dialysis and chemotherapy; and

WHEREAS, DJFS is responsible for providing the payment of invoices received from NET providers who have provided NET services to Summit County residents whom DJFS has deemed eligible for Medicaid services, with said payments being funded by federal pass-through Medicaid dollars; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.10(e) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, requires that additions to a purchase order by an officeholder that exceed 30% or \$25,000 whichever is greater, shall be made only upon authorization of this Council; and

WHEREAS, the DJFS has vendors that are best practical source providers and whose contracts were previously approved by the Board of Control pursuant to Directive No. 247-22 and adopted by this Council pursuant to Resolution No. 2022-266, which confirmed the award of professional service contracts authorizing the Executive to disburse funds to all Non-Emergency Medical Transportation providers operating under contract with the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services in Federal Fiscal Year 2023, for the period 10/1/22 through 9/30/23, with two options to renew for additional one-year terms, in an estimated total amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to execute Change Order No. 1 to increase the total NET contract amount for calendar year 2023 to \$4,400,000.00 for various vendors due to increased transportation needs for DJFS clients which exceeded original projections, as set forth in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully restated; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 for calendar year 2023 for various vendors, as set forth in Exhibit A;
