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7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Greenleaf Family Center, as a Best Practical Source, to provide assessments**
9 **to identify individuals who may require enhanced Court services through the Summit**
10 **County Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison program, from 7/1/23 through 6/30/24,**
11 **in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, for the Executive’s Department of Public Safety,**
12 **and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (“ODRC”)
15 previously awarded Community Corrections Act (“CCA”) 407 and 408 program grants, to
16 support housing and alternative community correction programming for felony and misdemeanor
17 offenders; a Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison (“TCAP”) grant, to assist in housing
18 felony 4 and 5 offenders locally, in lieu of transferring them to state prison; and a Justice
19 Reinvestment and Incentive Grant, which provides programming to offenders to reduce
20 recidivism; and

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22 WHEREAS, ODRC has combined these grant programs for the two-year grant cycle for
23 State Fiscal Years 2024-2025 into the Community Corrections Act 2.0 grant; and

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25 WHEREAS, under the CCA 2.0 grant program, ODRC awarded a grant in the amount of
26 \$7,597,903.00 to the County of Summit, for the period 7/1/23 through 6/30/25, with no local
27 cash match requirement to support maintaining offenders locally and being able to provide
28 alternative community corrections housing and programming; and

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30 WHEREAS, this grant funding is provided to Greenleaf Family Center to provide court
31 assessments to the Court of Common Pleas to identify individuals who may benefit from
32 enhanced court services; and

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34 WHEREAS, the initial term of this agreement shall be from 7/1/23 through 12/31/23,
35 with an option to renew the agreement on a monthly basis for an additional six months, for a
36 total term not to exceed one year; and

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38 WHEREAS, Greenleaf Family Center is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections
39 177.01(h)(4) and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit as they
40 currently provide court assessment services for the Court of Common Pleas since 2017 as well as
41 providing similar assessment services for various Summit County agencies and Courts since
42 2009; and

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44 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a professional service contract with the
45 Greenleaf Family Center to provide said programs and services to individuals; and

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47 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 16, 2023, awarded a
48 professional service contract with Greenleaf Family Center, as a Best Practical Source, to
49 provide assessments to identify individuals who may require enhanced Court services through
50 the Summit County CCA 2.0 grand program, from 7/1/23 through 6/30/24, in an amount not to
51 exceed \$100,00.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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4 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
5 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Greenleaf Family Center is necessary
6 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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8 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
9 of Ohio, that:

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11 SECTION 1

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13 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Greenleaf
14 Family Center, as a Best Practical Source, to provide court assessments to identify individuals
15 who may require enhanced Court services, from 7/1/23 through 6/30/24, in an amount not to
16 exceed \$100,00.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
17 professional service contract and any other necessary related documents.

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19 SECTION 2

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21 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and
22 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
23 continue to provide court assessments without interruption, effective 7/1/23.

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25 SECTION 3

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27 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
28 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
29 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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31 SECTION 4

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33 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
34 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
35 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
36 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
37 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
