RESOLUTION NO. 2023-281 1 2 SPONSOR <u>Exec</u>utive Shapiro & Council as a Whole 3 4 **Human Services** September 11, 2023 5 DATE COMMITTEE 6 7 A Resolution declaring the month of October 2023 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month in 8 Summit County, recognizing survivors, loved ones lost to breast cancer, and caregivers that supported individuals throughout their battles, reaffirming the need for early detection and 9 a cure for breast cancer, and encouraging residents to wear pink on October 20, 2023, for 10 11 this Council and the Executive, and declaring an emergency. 12 13 WHEREAS, the National Breast Cancer Foundation reports that in 2023 an estimated 14 297,790 women and 2,800 men will be diagnosed with invasive breast cancer and an estimated 15 43,700 women and 530 men will die of breast cancer in the United States; and 16 17 WHEREAS, breast cancer is the second leading cause of cancer among women in the 18 United States, with 1 in 8 women being diagnosed with breast cancer in their lifetimes; and 19 20 WHEREAS, there are over 3.8 million breast cancer survivors in the United States that 21 through advancements in prevention and care and through personal courage and strength have 22 survived breast cancer; and 23 24 WHEREAS, sadly, thousands of people are lost to breast cancer each year despite their 25 most valiant efforts and the support of their families, healthcare professionals, and communities; 26 27 28 WHEREAS, there are thousands of residents and families in Summit County impacted by 29 breast cancer; and 30 31 WHEREAS, by advocating for research to prevent, treat, and cure breast cancer, by 32 encouraging our loved ones to commit to routine screening, and by supporting our loved ones 33 through their struggles with breast cancer, our community can become happier and healthier; and 34 35 WHEREAS, residents are encouraged to wear pink on October 20, 2023 in recognition of 36 Breast Cancer Awareness Month and in solidarity with all those who have been impacted by breast 37 cancer; and 38 39 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, 40 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit that October 2023 be declared 41 Breast Cancer Awareness Month in Summit County, and encouraging the residents of Summit 42 County to join in this acknowledgement by wearing pink on October 20, 2023; 43 44 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State 45 of Ohio, that: 46 47 **SECTION 1** 48 49 The month of October 2023 is hereby declared Breast Cancer Awareness Month in Summit County, and the residents of Summit County are encouraged to join in this acknowledgement by 50 51 wearing pink on October 20, 2023.
