7 **A Resolution approving the 2023 wage reopener as agreed between Ohio Council 8 and**  
8 **Local 1229 (Fiscal Office and Office of Information Technology Unit) of the American**  
9 **Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and the Executive,**  
10 **Fiscal Officer, and the Office of Information Technology, for the third year of the parties’**  
11 **collective bargaining agreement (9/1/23 through 8/31/24), for the Executive, Fiscal Office**  
12 **and the Office of Information Technology, and declaring an emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2021-342, a collective bargaining agreement  
15 (“CBA”) and memorandum of understanding were approved between Ohio Council 8 and Local  
16 1229 (Fiscal Office and Office of Information Technology Unit) of the American Federation of  
17 State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (collectively, the “Union”), and the  
18 Executive, Fiscal Officer, and the Office of Information Technology (collectively the “County”),  
19 for the period 9/1/21 through 8/31/24, with a reopener on wages in the third year of the  
20 agreement (9/1/2023); and

22 WHEREAS, the County and the Union have reached an agreement on the 2023 wage  
23 reopener with an increase in pay of four percent (4.0%) for the third year of the CBA (effective  
24 9/1/2023); and

25  
26 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
27 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to approve the wage reopener between  
28 the Union and the County, as agreed between the parties;

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
31 of Ohio, that:

35 The agreement on the wage reopener between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 (Fiscal  
36 Office and Office of Information Technology Unit) of the American Federation of State, County  
37 and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (collectively, the “Union”), and the Executive, Fiscal  
38 Officer, and the Office of Information Technology (collectively the “County”), for the third year  
39 of the collective bargaining agreement, effective September 1, 2023, is hereby approved,  
40 authorizing an increase in pay of four percent (4.0%).

44 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
45 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the for the further purpose of providing  
46 a timely wage increase for Local 1229 (Fiscal Office and Office of Information Technology  
47 Unit) of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO.
