Swindell) 3 SPONSOR Executive Shapiro 4 5 DATE October 30, 2023 COMMITTEE Public Works 6 7 A Resolution to cooperate with the Director of Transportation in a City of Barberton 8 9 sponsored project to improve Wooster Road West located in the City of Barberton, in **Council District 7, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.** 10 11 WHEREAS, the City of Barberton in cooperation with the Ohio Department of 12 Transportation (ODOT) has developed and funded a project on Wooster Road West to resurface 13 Wooster Road from 31st Street to Hudson Run Road and reconstruct Wooster Road from Hudson 14 Run Road to 2nd Street NW, including sewer improvements and reduction of through lanes from 15 four lanes to two lanes with a two way left turn lane together with the addition of wider 16 sidewalks to increase pedestrian safety, which project is identified as SUM Wooster Road West 17 (PID 108240); and has enacted Preliminary Participatory Legislation consenting to such project 18 and agreeing to participate in costs; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the proposed improvement crosses two Summit County owned bridges 21 SUM-11-0270 (Hudson Run) and SUM - 10 - 0361 (Wolf Creek) that need to be rehabilitated to 22 accommodate the reduced pavement width and increased sidewalk width; and 23 24 WHEREAS, if the proposed bridge rehabilitation, namely concrete overlays of the 25 wearing surface only on the above-mentioned two bridges identified is not included in this 26 current project, the rehabilitation would be required soon after the completion of the city 27 improvement; and 28 29 WHEREAS, the preliminary estimate of costs of the bridge rehabilitation work only is 30 approximately \$250,000.00 which was presented to this Council for approval under Resolution 31 No. 2023-307 and if this Council authorizes the Executive to pay one hundred percent (100%) of 32 the costs of the bridge rehabilitation work on the bridges SUM-11-0270 (Hudson Run) and 33 SUM-10-0361 (Wolf Creek) but which is subject to further Council approval of final legislation 34 and a Local Public Authority ("LPA") Agreement specifying the County's portion of the project 35 costs to be paid; and 36 37 WHEREAS, this Council finds it is in the public interest to include the bridge 38 rehabilitation work within the above-mentioned Wooster Road West construction project and 39 after reviewing all pertinent information about the project and the bridge rehabilitation work, 40 finds and determines that acceptance and approval of participation and cooperation in the project 41 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit; and 42 43 44 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that: 45 46 47 **SECTION 1** 48 This Council hereby authorizes the Engineer to proceed with the bridge rehabilitation 49 work, namely concrete overlays of the wearing surface only on the above-noted bridges over 50 Wolf Creek and Hudson Run as part of the Ohio Department of Transportation's ("ODOT") 51 SUM Wooster Road West (PID 108240) project; and further authorizes the County to participate 52

The Executive is hereby 6 authorized to pay one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the 7 County and determined by ODOT and the Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary 8 for their portion of the project. The Executive is hereby authorized to execute any contracts 9 and/or other necessary related documents with the Director of Transportation as may be 10 necessary to complete the aforementioned project. 11 12 **SECTION 2** 13 14 15 This Council further authorizes the Executive to execute any change orders and extra works contracts required to fulfill the construction contracts as needed. The State shall not 16 approve a change order or extra work contract until it first gives notice, in writing, to the County. 17 The County shall contribute its share of the cost of these items in accordance with other sections 18 stated herein. Final legislation specifying the cost of the County's portion of the project and 19 providing for execution of a Local Public Authority ("LPA") Agreement with ODOT will be 20 proposed at a later date. 21 22 **SECTION 3** 23 24 Upon completion of the bridge rehabilitation portion of the described Project, and unless 25 otherwise agreed, the County shall: (1) to the extent required under Ohio law, provide adequate 26 maintenance for the bridge rehabilitation work only in accordance with all applicable state and 27 federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) if required to provide maintenance 28 under item #1, provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of bridge 29 rehabilitation portion of the described project; (3) to the extent that the County controls the right 30 of way within which the above-mentioned two bridges are located, maintain the right-of-way, 31 keeping it free of obstructions and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes. 32 33 34 **SECTION 4** 35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and 36 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately 37 facilitates safety improvements in the City of Barberton, in Council District 7. 38 39 **SECTION 4** 40 41 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take 42 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take 43 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law. 44 45 46 **SECTION 5** 47 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating 48 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all 49 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, 50 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 51
