A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (fourth and final) of a professional service contract with Sadler-NeCamp Financial Services, Inc. dba Proware, as a Best Practical Source, for case management system software support and maintenance services, for a one-year term, from 1/1/24 through 12/31/24, for an amount not to exceed \$207,930.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division (the "Court") utilizes proprietary case management software purchased from Sadler-NeCamp Financial Services, Inc. dba Proware ("Proware"); and

WHEREAS, Proware is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit because the case management system software support and maintenance services provided are for a proprietary system already being utilized by the Court; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-121, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Proware, as a Sole Source, subject to the approval of the Information Technology Board, for case management system software support and maintenance services, for a one-year term, from 1/1/20 through 12/31/20, for an amount not to exceed \$191,440.00 for the first year, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term, for a total cost not to exceed \$999,540.00 for the five-year period; and

WHEREAS, the Information Technology Board at its meeting held on May 14, 2020, adopted Directive No. IT 2020-12, which authorized the Executive to enter into the aforementioned professional service agreement with Proware; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-036, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of the first renewal of said professional service contract with Proware, as a Sole Source, for a one-year term, from 1/1/21 through 12/31/21, for an amount not to exceed \$195,815.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2022-056, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of the second renewal of said professional service contract with Proware, as a Best Practical Source, for a one-year term, from 1/1/22 through 12/31/22, for an amount not to exceed \$200,280.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2023-037, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of the third renewal of said professional service contract with Proware, as a Best Practical Source, for a one-year term, from 1/1/23 through 12/31/23, for an amount not to exceed \$204,075.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 13, 2024, awarded a renewal (fourth and final) of said professional service contract with Proware, as a Best Practical Source, for a one-year term, from 1/1/24 through 12/31/24, for an amount not to exceed \$207,930.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned third renewal of a professional service contract with Sadler-NeCamp Financial Services, Inc. dba Proware is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (fourth and final) of a professional service contract with Sadler-NeCamp Financial Services, Inc. dba Proware ("Proware"), as a Best Practical Source, for case management system software support and maintenance services, for a one-year term, from 1/1/24 through 12/31/24, for an amount not to exceed \$207,930.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said renewal and any other necessary related documents.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for the aforementioned case management system software support and maintenance services by Proware effective 1/1/24.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
