## SECTION 1

Pursuant to Section 6131.07 of the Ohio Revised Code, a legal notice shall be published one time in a newspaper of general circulation in Summit County; individual notice to all owners of land which will be benefitted or damaged by construction of the proposed improvement shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, giving notice that a public viewing of the area will take place at 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 16, 2024 at the Norwood Lake Homeowners Association pavilion area, located west of 156 Beachwood Drive, and east of 112 Beechwood Drive, and across the street from 131 Beechwood Drive, Northfield Center Township, Ohio 44067. A Public Hearing will take place on Monday, August 5, 2024 at 4:30 pm in Council Chambers, Ohio Building – 7th Floor, 175 South Main Street, Akron, Ohio.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the publication and notice of a viewing and hearing for a proposed public improvement located in Northfield Center Township, Summit County, Ohio.

## **SECTION 3**
