A Resolution authorizing the Executive to advertise for bids for the construction of Project Q-453 Fishcreek Wastewater Treatment Plant #25 for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$5,900,000.00, and to authorize the Executive to apply for and execute a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund Agreement for a loan in an amount not to exceed \$8,100,000.00 to fund the project, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, and repealing Resolution No. 2023-152 and Resolution No. 2020-067, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously approved Resolution No. 2020-067, authorizing the Executive to advertise for bids for the construction of improvements to the Fishcreek Wastewater Treatment Plant #25 in the amount of \$3,500,000.00 ("Q-453 Project"); that authorization was repealed by Resolution No. 2023-152 which increased the bid amount to \$4,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of commencing the Q-453 Project, this Council previously approved Resolution No. 2019-376, authorizing the Executive to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund Agreement ("WPCLF") loan in the amount of \$3,500,000.00; that authorization was repealed by Resolution No. 2023-152, which increased the amount to \$4,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, as a result of additional scope added to the project to further enhance reclamation quality, the Q-453 Project now includes total costs for construction, engineering services and technical services, for a total cost of \$8,100,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to advertise for bids for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$5,900,000.00 for construction to improve and rehabilitate the plant facility, including the replacement of piping and pumps for the digesters, oxidation ditch, mechanical equipment and sludge pump station equipment, for Project Q-453 Fishcreek Wastewater Treatment Plant #25, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinance of the County of Summit requires this Council's authorization for the County to advertise for bids for construction contracts in excess of \$75,000.00; and

WHEREAS, copies of the plans and specifications for the Q-453 Project are on file with the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to apply for a WPCLF loan, with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority, for a 20-year loan term, to fund the Q-453 Project for the cost of construction and additional costs for engineering services and technical services, in a total amount not to exceed \$8,100,000.00, which will be in place of the loan previously authorized by Resolution. No. 2019-376; and

WHEREAS, a WPCLF loan requires the legislative authority of the County to adopt legislation for the application of loans, the execution of agreements and the designation of repayment sources; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to repeal Resolution No. 2020-067, which previously authorized the County to advertise for bids for the Q-453 Project at an estimated total cost not to exceed \$3,500,000.00 and repeal Resolution No. 2023-152 which increased the amount to \$4,000,000.00, due to additional work that is necessary to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to advertise for bids for the construction of the Q-453 Project for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$5,900,000.00, to apply for and execute the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund Agreement for the Q-453 Project for the costs of construction, engineering services and technical services, in a total amount not to exceed \$8,100,000.00 and designate repayment from the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund, and, as a result of the foregoing, to repeal Resolution No. 2020-067 and repeal Resolution No. 2023-152;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## **SECTION 1**

Resolution No. 2020-067 and Resolution No. 2023-152 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

## **SECTION 2**

The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of Project Q-453 Fishcreek Wastewater Treatment Plant #25 ("Q-453 Project"), located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$5,900,000.00.

## **SECTION 3**

The Executive is hereby authorized to apply for and execute a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund Agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for a loan, with a term of 20 years, for the costs of construction, engineering services and technical services, in an amount not to exceed \$8,100,000.00, to fund Project Q-453, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of the loan agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, and any other necessary documents related to the loan. This Council further designates the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund as the dedicated source of repayment for the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan.

## **SECTION 4**

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately advertise for bids for the construction of Project Q-453 and execute a necessary agreement and loan document so that the project may proceed in a timely manner.
