7 **An Amended Resolution declaring it necessary to submit to the electors of the County of**  
8 **Summit the question of the renewal of an existing tax levy, of 3.25 mills, for the programs**  
9 **and services of the Summit County Childrens Services Board and requesting the Fiscal**  
10 **Officer to certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the County and**  
11 **the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal levy, for the Summit**  
12 **County Childrens Services Board, and declaring an emergency.**

13  
14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

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16 SECTION 1.

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18 This Council makes the following findings and determinations:

- 19  
20 (a) The Summit County Childrens Services Board (the "SCCSB") has requested this  
21 Council to submit to the voters the question of the renewal of its existing tax levy.  
22 (*See Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated*). The  
23 ~~SCCSB has requested the~~ Social Services Advisory Board (the "SSAB") ~~to~~ has  
24 reviewed and approve recommended that this Council place upon the ballot at the  
25 election on November 5, 2024 the its proposal for the Tax Levy (as defined  
26 below).
- 27  
28 (b) This Council is the taxing authority of Summit County pursuant to Article III,  
29 Section 3.01 of the County Charter and under Section 5705.01 of the Ohio  
30 Revised Code.
- 31  
32 (c) The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be  
33 insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the SCCSB.
- 34  
35 (d) It is necessary to renew the 3.25 mill tax levy (the "Tax Levy"), for the benefit  
36 operation of the Summit County Childrens Services Board, established under  
37 Chapter 5153 of the Ohio Revised Code, for the purpose of providing services to  
38 children and families supporting children services and the care and placement of  
39 children, to run for a period of six (6) years, beginning with the 2025 tax list and  
40 duplicate, for collection in the years 2026 through 2031, inclusive, pursuant to  
41 Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19, 5705.191, and 5705.24; and

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43 SECTION 2.

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45 The Tax Levy will have the following terms:

47 (a) The Tax Levy will be levied upon the entire territory of Summit County under the  
48 authority of Sections 5705.19, 5705.191, and 5705.24 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- 49  
50 (b) The Tax Levy will renew an existing 3.25 mill levy to constitute a tax of 3.25  
51 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 32.50 cents for each  
52 one hundred dollars of tax valuation.

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4 SECTION 2. (Continued)

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6 (c) The Tax Levy will be for a six-year period of time, beginning on the tax list and  
7 duplicate for the year 2025 (collection year 2026). The proceeds of the tax levy  
8 would be distributed to the County in 2026 through 2031, inclusive.

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10 SECTION 3.

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12 In accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council authorizes  
13 and requests the Clerk of Council to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Fiscal Officer to  
14 certify to this Council the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of  
15 revenue that would be generated by the Tax Levy in the amount of 3.25 mills expressed in  
16 dollars, rounded to the nearest dollar, for each one hundred thousand dollars of the County Fiscal  
17 Officer's appraised value.

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19 SECTION 4.

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21 Upon receipt of the Fiscal Officer's certification and receipt of the SSAB's approval, this  
22 Council will consider for enactment legislation to submit the question of the Tax Levy to the  
23 voters of the entire territory of the County of Summit at the November 5, 2024 general election.

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25 SECTION 5.

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27 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
28 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately  
29 enable the Fiscal Officer to calculate the amounts requested in Section 3 and to certify the  
30 question to the Board of Elections in time for the November 5, 2024 election.

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32 SECTION 6.

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34 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
35 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
36 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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38 SECTION 7.

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40 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
41 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
42 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action  
43 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
44 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
