7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the**
8 **Information Technology Board, of a professional service contract with Tyler Technologies,**
9 **Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for the case management system at the Jail, for a one-year**
10 **term, for the period of 7/1/24 to 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed \$259,905.50, for the**
11 **Office of Information Technology and Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, due to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, it was necessary
14 to replace the case management system at the Jail to limit personal contact while expanding the
15 capabilities of providing accurate reporting and monitoring; and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-359, which confirmed
18 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Tyler Technologies, Inc.,
19 as a Best Practical Source, for a case management system at the Jail, in an amount not to exceed
20 \$1,003,406.00; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Sheriff wishes to enter into a professional service contract with Tyler
23 Technologies, Inc. for continued use of its Corrections Suite and Mobility jail case management
24 software; and

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26 WHEREAS, due to the Jail’s past implementation and continued use of Corrections Suite
27 and Mobility case management software and Tyler Technologies, Inc.’s understanding of the
28 technical aspects of the application and specific knowledge of the Jail, Tyler Technologies, Inc. is
29 a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified
30 Ordinances of the County of Summit, and as such is exempt from competitive bidding; and

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32 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on May 22, 2024, awarded a
33 professional service contract, subject to the approval of the Information Technology Board, with
34 Tyler Technologies, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for the case management system at the Jail,
35 for a one-year term, for the period of 7/1/24 to 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed \$259,905.50,
36 subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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38 WHEREAS, the aforementioned professional service contract with Tyler Technologies,
39 Inc., approved by the Board of Control as a Best Practical Source, will be presented to the
40 Information Technology Board at its meeting to be held June 25, 2024; and

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42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
43 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Tyler Technologies, Inc., subject to
44 approval by the Information Technology Board, is necessary and in the best interest of the County
45 of Summit;

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6 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract, subject to the
7 approval of the Information Technology Board, with Tyler Technologies, Inc., as a Best Practical
8 Source, for the case management system at the Jail, for a one-year term, for the period of 7/1/24
9 to 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed \$259,905.50, hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby
10 authorized to execute said professional service contract and any other necessary related document

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
16 provides for uninterrupted case management system service at the Jail.

21 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and
22 be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
