13	WHEREAS, the Summit County Court of Common Pleas (the "Court") must have the			
14	ability to determine the proper level of treatment and services for court-involved individuals who			

ability to determine the proper level of treatment and services for court-involved individuals who remain in local custody; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction ("ODRC") previously awarded Summit County a State Fiscal Year 24-25 Community Corrections Act ("CCA") grant in the amount of \$7,597,903.00, for the period 7/1/23 through 6/30/25, with no local cash match requirement, to provide officials funding to house felony 4 and 5 offenders locally, in lieu of transferring them to state prison, and to provide alternative community corrections programming and services for felony and misdemeanor offenders; and

WHEREAS, the Court has previously engaged Greenleaf Family Center ("Greenleaf") to provide assessments, which are paid for through CCA funding, to ensure court-involved individuals are receiving appropriate programs and services; and

WHEREAS, the Court wishes to continue to have Greenleaf provide assessments, for the period of 7/1/24 through 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed \$189,900.00, through the use of CCA funding; and

WHEREAS, Greenleaf is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4) and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit as they have been providing court assessment services for the Court since 2017, as well as providing similar assessment services for various County agencies since 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a professional service contract with Greenleaf to provide said assessments for court-involved individuals; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 29, 2024, awarded a professional service contract with Greenleaf, as a Best Practical Source, to provide assessments to identify court-involved individuals who may require enhanced programs or services, for the period 7/1/24 through 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed \$189,900.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional service contract with Greenleaf is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
