36 37	SECTION 5.10 FAIRNESS IN COUNTY EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBLITY.		
38 39	In the interest of providing proper and reasonable protection against the negative aspects of nepotism, the following prohibitions are established:		
40 41 42 43 44 45 46	(A) No person shall be eligible for <u>Charter County</u> employment if the person is related to an elected <u>Charter County</u> official, unclassified <u>Charter County</u> employee, or <u>Charter County</u> employee at the level of Director or <u>County employee whose County salary exceeds \$80,000 per year</u> , as a spouse, sister, brother, child, parent, half-sister, half-brother, step-child, step-parent, step-sister, step-brother, grandparent, grandchild, father-in-law, mother-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, <u>aunt</u> , <u>uncle</u> , niece, nephew or cousin of the first		

(B) No person shall have supervisory responsibility over their spouse, sister, brother, child, parent, half-sister, half-brother, step-child, step-parent, step-sister, step-brother,

SECTION 3 (Continued)

grandparent, grandchild, father-in-law, mother-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, <u>aunt</u>, <u>uncle</u>, niece, nephew, or cousin of the first degree.

(C) This Section shall govern only those seeking County employment after the effective date of this Section and does not prohibit the continued employment by the County of any person who holds County employment on or before the effective date of this Section. This Section also does not prohibit the continued employment by the County of a person employed by the County prior to the election of a County elected official who is related to the employee as a spouse, sister, brother, child, parent, half-sister, half-brother, step-child, step-parent, step-sister, step-brother, grandparent, grandchild, father-in-law, mother-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew or cousin of the first degree.

(D) Any person hired in violation of this Section shall be immediately terminated. The County Fiscal Officer shall not make salary payments to persons hired in violation of this Section.

SECTION 4

The Clerk of Council shall certify the question set forth herein to the Summit County Board of Elections no later than the ninetieth (90th) day prior to the General Election of November 5, 2024.

SECTION 5

Notice of the proposed amendment set forth herein shall be given by the Clerk of Council by publishing the full text of the proposed amendment once a week for at least two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper published in the County as set forth in Section 307.70 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6

 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to ensure that this Resolution takes effect before the Board of Elections' deadline for submitting the proposed Charter Amendment.

SECTION 7

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds by council members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
