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35	SECTION 2.03 POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE.
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37	The County Executive shall have all the powers and duties of an administrative nature
38	under this Charter and responsibility for the day-to-day running of the departments, offices and
39	agencies of County government under his or her jurisdiction and control. Such powers and duties
