Nelsen) 3 SPONSOR Executive Shapiro 4 5 DATE June 3, 2024 COMMITTEE Public Safety 6 7 A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc., for continued assessment, strategic plan development and 8 9 consulting services in developing the Summit County Public Safety Fiber and Communications Network, in an amount not to exceed \$442,945.23, for the Executive and 10 11 declaring an emergency. 12 13 WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the President signed the American Rescue Plan Act of 14 2021, ("ARPA") section 9901, Pub.LNo.117-2 codified at 42 U.S.C. section 802 et seq., 15 providing funds to support state, local and tribal governments in responding to the continuing 16 and evolving impact of COVID-19 on their communities; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the safety and security of the residents of the County of Summit is of 19 paramount importance to elected officials throughout the County; and 20 21 WHEREAS, in furtherance of that goal and pursuant to a cooperative agreement 22 approved by this Council pursuant to Resolution 2022-192, the County desires to invest both 23 local and ARPA funds into the Summit County Public Safety Fiber and Communications 24 Network Project ("SCPSFCN") to construct a fiber ring, data center and related substation to 25 service the fiber ring also approved as part of the cooperative agreement, in order to enhance 26 broadband infrastructure investments to address challenges with broadband access, affordability, 27 and reliability and to address public safety needs with the County; and 28 29 WHEREAS, to further the goal of achieving such a system in a cost-effective manner, the 30 Executive solicited proposals to find a firm to provide consulting services necessary for planning 31 and project management in the planning and implementation of the Project; and 32 33 WHEREAS, upon evaluating the proposals received, the Executive recommended MCM 34 Consulting Group, Inc. ("MCM") to provide such services; and 35 36 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on November 23, 2022, authorized 37 a professional service contract with MCM, through BOC Res. 351-22, in a total amount not to 38 exceed \$2,824,333.48 for the aforementioned services; and 39 40 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2022-361, which authorized the Executive, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to execute a 41 42 professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc., for assessment, strategic plan 43 development and consulting services in developing the Summit County Public Safety Fiber and 44 Communications Network and, in an initial amount not to exceed \$506,162.50; and 45 46 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to execute an additional professional services contract 47 with MCM Consulting Group, Inc. for the continuation of services, in an amount not to exceed 48 \$442,945.23, thereby bringing the total actually contracted with MCM as authorized by BOC 49 Res. 351-22 to \$949,107.73; and 50 51 52

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2024-185 2 PAGE TWO 3 4 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, 5 that said professional service contract with MCM is necessary and in the best interest of the 6 County of Summit; and 7 8 WHEREAS, this Council further finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent 9 information, that authorizing the professional service agreement with MCM in an amount not to exceed \$442,945.23 to further the Project is necessary due to the public health emergency 10 created by the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in accordance with the requirements of 11 12 the ARPA interim final rule, and pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, ("ARPA") 13 section 9901, Pub.LNo.117-2 codified at 42 U.S.C. section 802 et seq.; 14 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State 16 of Ohio, that: 17 18 **SECTION 1** 19 20 This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of \$442,945.23 under the 21 aforementioned professional service agreement is necessary due to the public health emergency 22 with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic and is being done in compliance with the provisions of 23 the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, ("ARPA") section 9901, Pub.LNo.117-2 codified at 42 24 U.S.C. section 802 et seq and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional 25 service contract and any other necessary related documents. 26 27 **SECTION 2** 28 29 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and 30 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately 31 provide project management for the development of a comprehensive public safety broadband 32 network. 33 34 **SECTION 3** 35 36 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take 37 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take 38 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law. 39 40 **SECTION 4** 41 42 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating 43 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all 44 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, 45 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 46 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. 47 48 49 50 51 52
