7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (fourth and final)**
8 **of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for detention center**
9 **youth food services, for a one-year term, from 7/1/24 through 6/30/25, for a total amount**
10 **not to exceed \$300,000.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and declaring**
11 **an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-136, which confirmed
14 the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services,
15 LLC, for detention center youth food services, for the period of 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, with four
16 options to renew for a one-year period, in an estimated amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 for the
17 first year, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division; and

18

19 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-197, which
20 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of four) of a purchase contract
21 with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for detention center youth food services, for the
22 period of 7/1/21 through 6/30/22, for a total amount not to exceed \$220,000.00 for the Court of
23 Common Pleas-Juvenile Division; and

24

25 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2022-214, which
26 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of four) of a purchase
27 contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for detention center youth food services, for
28 the period of 7/1/21 through 6/30/22, for a total amount not to exceed \$220,000.00, for the Court
29 of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division; and

31 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2023-190, which
32 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (third of four) of a purchase contract
33 with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for detention center youth food services, for a one-
34 year term, from 7/1/23 through 6/30/24, for a total amount not to exceed \$260,000.00, for the
35 Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division; and

36

37 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 5, 2024, awarded a renewal
38 (fourth and final) of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for detention
39 center youth food services, for a one-year term, from 7/1/24 through 6/30/25, in an amount not to
40 exceed \$4.586 to \$8.7999 per meal based on the number of youth served and \$0.950 per snack,
41 for a total amount not to exceed \$300,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

43 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
44 that the aforementioned renewal of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services,
45 LLC is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

4 SECTION 1

6 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (fourth and final) of a purchase contract
7 with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for detention center youth food services, for a one-
8 year term, from 7/1/24 through 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed \$4.586 to \$8.7999 per meal
9 based on the number of youth served and \$0.950 per snack, for a total amount not to exceed
10 \$300,000.00, is hereby confirmed, and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
11 renewal and any other necessary related documents.

13 SECTION 2

15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
16 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
17 provide detention center youth food services effective 7/1/24.

19 SECTION 3

21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

25 SECTION 4

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
28 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
30 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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


