A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the University of Akron, on behalf of the Sheriff's Office, concerning the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy, for the Executive and Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2022-311, which approved the establishment and classification of the classified position of Deputy Sheriff Cadet to encourage recruitment of Deputy Sheriffs to attend and participate in the University of Akron ("University")/Sheriff's Office Police Academy; and

WHEREAS, the University and the County wish to share facilities, services and personnel to train Deputy Sheriff Cadets seeking Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy ("OPOTA") certification in a cost effective manner; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the University and County to execute an agreement setting forth each party's responsibilities in this endeavor; and

WHEREAS, the County agrees to pay the University, the tuitions for the above-referenced cadets in an amount not exceeding \$150,000.00 per year for a five-year period and the University agrees to provide adequate facilities for instruction and pay for instruction provided by the County, with a copy of said Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to enter into an intergovernmental agreement, on behalf of the Sheriff's Office, with the University for the payment of the aforementioned tuition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the University of Akron, on behalf of the Sheriff's Office, to outline responsibilities and financial contributions of each party concerning the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy. The final agreement will be in substantially the same form of the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to provide proper training for cadets desiring to serve as local law enforcement officers.
