7 **A Resolution authorizing the Ohio Department of Transportation to perform the milling**
8 **and resurfacing of Stow Road, as part of the project to improve the Interstate 480 bridges**
9 **over Stow Road, PID No. 111186, at no cost to the County, located in Twinsburg Township,**
10 **in Council District 1, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

11
12 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation (“ODOT”) has planned
13 improvements to the Interstate 480 bridges over Stow Road (the “Project”) in located in
14 Twinsburg Township, in Council District 1;

15
16 WHEREAS, ODOT and the Engineer have determined that construction work on the
17 Interstate 480 bridges will cause additional surface deterioration to Stow Road (County Highway
18 106); and

19
20 WHEREAS, ODOT has proposed milling and resurfacing the affected portion of Stow
21 Road as part of the Project, at no cost to the County; and

22
23 WHEREAS, in order to proceed with construction work on a County owned road, ODOT
24 requires consent legislation from this Council; and

25
26 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
27 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Ohio Department of
28 Transportation to make the necessary repairs to Stow Road;

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that;

33 Section 1

34
35 The County of Summit consents to the Ohio Department of Transportation completing
36 the milling and resurfacing of Stow Road (County Highway 106), under the Interstate 480
37 bridges (the “Project”), located in Twinsburg Township, in Council District 1.

38
39 Section 2

40
41 The Engineer, as the Local Public Agency, shall cooperate with the Director of
42 Transportation in the above-described project.

43
44 Section 3

45
46 The State of Ohio shall assume and bear 100% of all costs of the Project. Though no
47 special requests are anticipated, the Engineer agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features
48 requested by the Engineer, which are determined by the State and Federal Highway
49 Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

6 The Engineer agrees that all right-of-way required for the Project will be acquired and/or
7 made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations and the Engineer further
8 understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

10 Section 5

12 The Engineer agrees that upon completion of the Project, the Engineer shall provide
13 adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and
14 federal law, including but not limited to 23 USC 116; provide ample financial provisions, as
15 necessary, for the maintenance of the Project, maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of
16 obstructions, and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

18 Section 6

19

20 The Clerk of the Council of the County of Summit shall provide a certified copy of the
21 legislation to the Ohio Department of Transportation.

22

23 Section 7

24

25 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
26 welfare of the residents of Summit County, and for the further reason that it will expedite a
27 highway project to repair a County-owned road.

28

29 Section 8

30

31 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
32 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
33 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

34

35 Section 9

36

37 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
38 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
39 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
40 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
41 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
