A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a Gift Agreement with the Akron Community Foundation for the establishment of a Field of Interest Fund to support and enhance the health and safety of minority and disadvantaged County of Summit residents, and authorizing the contribution of an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.00 of Opioid Settlement Dollars, for the Executive, the Opiate Abatement Advisory Council, and the Key Stakeholders Group, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 2019-332 and 2019-361, this Council authorized the Executive to settle any or all claims, and to execute any corresponding settlement agreements, in litigation titled In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation, Case No. 1:17-MD 2804, before Judge Dan Aaron Polster in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio (the "Lawsuit"), resulting in an unprecedented amount of settlements; and

WHEREAS, the Executive convened the Key Stakeholders Group and the Opiate Abatement Advisory Council ("OAAC") to help determine how to spend the opiate money to best serve the residents of the County; and

WHEREAS, an Opiate Abatement Strategy was developed as a guiding document for expending settlement monies, and identified four pillars of focus: (1) treatment, (2) system and infrastructure, (3) harm reduction, and (4) education; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit has a unique opportunity to dedicate funds to support the health and safety of minority and disadvantaged County residents and the County plans to commit funds for the purpose of addressing the significant health and safety issued faced by its minority and disadvantaged residents with a focus on historically marginalized and underrepresented communities, with the goal of improving the overall health and safety of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit plans to accomplish the aforementioned objective by establishing a Field of Interest Fund ("FOIF") of the Akron Community Foundation ("ACF"), as described in the Executive Summary and Term Sheet, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the FOIF will be led by an advisory committee comprised of subject matter experts who bring a diversity of thought and lived experiences, through which thought leaders and experts will participate in framing the FOIF's initiatives; and

WHEREAS, it is expected that the FOIF will be used to address systemic inequities in addiction prevention, treatment, and recovery; support innovative programming tailored to underserved communities; build capacity within minority and disadvantaged resident-led organizations and communities to expand their impact; and act as a convener; and

WHEREAS, this initiative will be a unique and longstanding dedication of funds that could transform healthcare programs and outcomes, ultimately advancing the social determinates of health, wellbeing, and public safety of County residents; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute a Gift Agreement and any other necessary related documents with the Akron Community Foundation in order to establish a Field of Interest Fund, in accordance with the terms of Exhibit A, and to contribute an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Gift Agreement and any other necessary related documents with the Akron Community Foundation in order to establish a Field of Interest Fund, in accordance with the terms of the Executive Summary and Term Sheet, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein by reference, and to contribute an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.00 of Opioid Settlement Dollars, to support and enhance the health and safety of minority and disadvantaged County of Summit residents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the immediate creation and funding of the aforementioned Field of Interest Fund.

SECTION 3

 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
