1 RESOLUTION NO. 2025-014 2 3 SPONSOR Executive Shapiro, Council as a Whole 4 5 COMMITTEE Committee of the Whole DATE January 6, 2025 6 7 A Resolution determining to proceed with submitting the question of the Issuance of Library 8 Improvement Bonds, in the aggregate principal amount of \$160,000,000.00 to the electors 9 residing within the boundaries of Akron-Summit County Public Library, pursuant to 10 Sections 133.18 and 3375.43 of the Ohio Revised Code, and declaring an emergency. 11 12 WHEREAS, the Board of Library Trustees (the "Library Board") of Akron-Summit 13 County Public Library (the "Library") adopted Resolution No. 24-126 on December 12, 2024 (the 14 "Resolution of Necessity") declaring the necessity of submitting to the electors residing within the 15 boundaries of the Library the question of the issuance bonds (the "Bonds") in the aggregate principal amount of \$160,000,000.00, for the purpose set forth in Section 1 of this Resolution and 16 the levy of a tax to pay debt charges on the Bonds and any anticipatory securities at an election to 17 18 be held on May 6, 2025, a copy of which was certified to the Summit County Fiscal Officer. 19 20 WHEREAS, the Summit County Fiscal Officer certified on December 20, 2024 (on DTE 21 130) (the "County Fiscal Officer Certificate") that (i) the total taxable value of the territory served 22 by the Library used in calculating the average annual property tax levy is \$12,244,063,550 and (ii) 23 the estimated average annual property tax levy required throughout the stated maximum maturity 24 of the Bonds to pay the interest of the Bonds and retire the principal over 20 years is calculated to 25 be is 1.0 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$35 for each \$100,000 of the County 26 Fiscal Officer's appraised value. 27 28 WHEREAS, after receipt of the County Fiscal Officer Certificate, the Library Board 29 adopted Resolution No. 24-128 on December 20, 2024 (the "Resolution to Proceed") requesting 30 this Council to submit to the electors residing within the boundaries of the Library the question of 31 the Bonds (and related tax levy) pursuant to Sections 133.18 and 3375.43 of the Ohio Revised 32 Code. 33 34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State 35 of Ohio, that: 36 37 SECTION 1. 38 39 This Council determines to proceed with submitting to the electors residing within the 40 boundaries of the Library, pursuant to Sections 133.18 and 3375.43 of the Ohio Revised Code, at an election to be held on May 6, 2025, the question of issuing bonds in the amount of 41 42 \$160,000,000.00, to be issued by the County as the taxing and bond-issuing authority of the 43 Library, for the purpose of constructing, adding to, renovating, remodeling, furnishing, equipping 44 and otherwise improving library buildings and facilities, and acquiring, clearing and improving 45 the sites thereof (the "Bonds"), and levying a tax to pay the debt charges on the Bonds and on any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds. The average annual property tax levy required throughout 46 47 the stated maturity of the Bonds to pay the interest on the Bonds and retire the principal over 20 48 years has been calculated by the Summit County Fiscal Officer to be 1.0 mill for each \$1 of taxable 49 value, which amounts to \$35 for each \$100,000 of the Summit County Fiscal Officer's appraised 50 value. This Council estimates that the tax for debt charges will first be levied in tax year 2025 and 51 first be collected in calendar year 2026. 52

11	that election and prepare the necessary ballots and supplies for the election in accordance with law.
