8 **service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case**  
9 **managers and ~~one full-time recovery support specialist~~, to provide support and treatment**  
10 **services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year term, from 9/30/24 through 9/29/25, in**  
11 **an amount not to exceed ~~\$207,467.00~~ \$140,212.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General**  
12 **Division, Adult Probation, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-091, which confirmed  
15 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a  
16 Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support  
17 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year  
18 term, from 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, in an amount not to exceed \$210,332.00; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-015, which  
21 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,  
22 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support  
23 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year  
24 term, from 9/30/20 through 9/29/21, in an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49; and

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26 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-277, which  
27 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,  
28 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support  
29 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year  
30 term, from 9/30/21 through 9/29/22, in an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49; and

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32 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2022-339, which  
33 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,  
34 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support  
35 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year  
36 term, from 9/30/22 through 9/29/23, in an amount not to exceed \$229,183.00; and

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38 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2023-378, which  
39 confirmed award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,  
40 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support  
41 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year  
42 term, from 9/30/23 through 9/29/24, in an amount not to exceed \$201,490.00; and

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44 WHEREAS, based on performance reviews and Oriana House Inc.'s specialized  
45 knowledge and previous years working with the Valor Court, the Court of Common Pleas-General  
46 Division, Adult Probation, wishes to enter into a professional service contract with Oriana House,  
47 Inc., as a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and 177.07(a)(5) of the  
48 Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, for a one-year term, from 9/30/24 through 9/29/25,  
49 in an amount not to exceed ~~\$207,467.00~~ \$140,212.00, to be funded by a no cost extension for  
50 Fiscal Year 2025 Treatment Drug Courts grant from the United States Department of Health and  
51 Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration ("SAMSHA") for  
52 the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project; and

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4 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 6, 2024, awarded said  
5 professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for a one-year  
6 term, from 9/30/24 through 9/29/25, in an amount not to exceed ~~\$207,467.00~~ \$140,212.00, subject  
7 to confirmation by this Council; and

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9 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
10 that the aforementioned renewal of the professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is  
11 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

18 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,  
19 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and ~~one full-time recovery support~~  
20 ~~specialist~~, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year  
21 term, from 9/30/24 through 9/29/25, in an amount not to exceed ~~\$207,467.00~~ \$140,212.00, is  
22 hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service  
23 contract and any other necessary related documents.

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25 SECTION 2

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27 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare  
28 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately authorizes  
29 necessary support and treatment services for Valor Court participants.

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31 SECTION 3

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33 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect  
34 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and  
35 be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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39 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
40 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
41 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in  
42 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22  
43 of the Ohio Revised Code.
