7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**  
8 **Geauga Highway Co. for the Cleveland Massillon Sidewalk Project, located in the Bath**  
9 **Township, in Council District 5, in amount not to exceed \$445,246.24, for the Engineer, and**  
10 **declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Executive and Engineer applied for Transportation Alternative Program  
13 dollars on behalf on Bath Township for the construction of a sidewalk on the west side of  
14 Cleveland Massillon Road from SR 18 to Springside Drive. The application was successful, and  
15 the Engineer will administer the project for Bath Township; however, all local matching funds  
16 will be paid by Bath Township; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2022-355, which authorized  
19 the Executive to enter into a Local Public Agency agreement with the State of Ohio for the  
20 Project; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2022-372, which  
23 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with  
24 Environmental Design Group, Inc. for the design of the Cleveland Massillon Sidewalk Project  
25 (the "Project"), located in the Bath Township, in Council District 5; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Project will consist of the construction of a five (5) foot wide concrete  
28 walkway on the west side of Cleveland Massillon Road from the north side of SR 18 (Medina  
29 Road) to the north side of Springside Drive. The length of the improvement is 2,365 feet and  
30 includes minor grading, drainage improvements, driveway modification and restoration or turf;  
31 and

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33 WHEREAS, the Engineer sent out nine bid packages, of which five bids were received,  
34 and the Executive has selected Geauga Highway Co. as the lowest responsive and responsible  
35 bidder; and

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37 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on February 5, 2025, awarded a  
38 construction contract with Geauga Highway Co., as the lowest responsive and responsible  
39 bidder, for the Cleveland Massillon Sidewalk Project, located in the Bath Township, in Council  
40 District 5, in amount not to exceed \$445,246.24, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
43 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Geauga Highway Co. is necessary and  
44 in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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46 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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6 The award by the Board of Control a construction contract with Geauga Highway Co. for  
7 completion of the Cleveland Massillon Sidewalk Project (the "Project"), located in the Bath  
8 Township, in Council District 5, in amount not to exceed \$445,246.24, is hereby confirmed and  
9 the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary  
10 related documents.

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12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
16 provide for necessary construction work for the Project.

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18 SECTION 3

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
29 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
30 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
