This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately pronounce that this Council urge Ohio's 136th General Assembly to adopt Senate Bill 109 to provide breakfast and lunch at no cost to public and chartered nonpublic school students.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 6
