NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

- (a) The Northeast Ohio Joint Office of Economic Development (the "JOED") and Summit County, in cooperation with the Summit County Development Finance Authority (the "DFA"), are authorized to make application to the FTZ Board and to take all necessary actions to transfer the grant of authority for FTZ 181 to the DFA.
- (b) Summit County, as administrator for the JOED, is authorized to transfer FTZ 181 records to the DFA or retain such records as it determines appropriate according to Ohio law.
- (c) Upon the FTZ Board's approval of the transfer of the grant of authority for FTZ 181 to the DFA, and without the need for further action by this Council, this Council authorizes the dissolution and termination of the JOED pursuant to Sections 9 and 10 of the JOED Amended Cooperative Agreement. Should the FTZ Board determine not to approve the transfer of the grant of authority for FTZ 181 to the DFA, the dissolution of the JOED shall not become effective.
- (d) This Council, pursuant to Section 8 of the JOED Amended Cooperative Agreement, hereby requests a Special Meeting of the JOED Council be scheduled by the JOED Chairman to take actions consistent with this Resolution.
- (e) This Council authorizes Summit County's representative to the JOED, Executive Ilene Shapiro, and alternate, Diane Miller-Dawson, to vote for the transfer of FTZ 181 to the DFA and to vote for the dissolution of the JOED consistent with this Resolution at the JOED Council meeting being called for this purpose, and to provide the JOED Council with a copy of this Resolution.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Summit County, and for the further purpose to immediately authorize this Council's representative to the JOED Council to carry out the actions authorized herein.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
