The Tax Levy will have the following terms: (a) The Tax Levy will be levied upon the entire territory of Summit County under the authority of Section 5705.221 of the Revised Code. (b) The Tax Levy will be a renewal of the Existing Levy and an increase of 0.5 mills, to constitute a tax of 3.45 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to \$75 dollars for each one hundred thousand dollars of County Fiscal Officer appraised value, pursuant to Section 5705.221 of the Revised Code. The Tax Levy will be for a six-year period of time, beginning on the tax list and (c) duplicate for the tax year 2026 (collection year 2027). The proceeds of the tax levy would be distributed to the County in the years 2027 through 2032, inclusive. SECTION 3. In accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council authorizes and requests the Clerk of Council to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Fiscal Officer to certify to this Council the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the Tax Levy in the amount of 3.45 mills expressed in dollars, rounded to the nearest dollar, for each one hundred thousand dollars of the Fiscal Officer's appraised value. SECTION 4. Upon receipt of the Fiscal Officer's certification, this Council intends to submit the question of the renewal of the Existing Levy to the electors of the entire territory of the County of Summit at an election on November 4, 2025, pursuant to Section 5705.221 of the Ohio Revised Code. SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately enable the Fiscal Officer to calculate the amounts requested in Section 3 and to certify the question to the Board of Elections in time for the November 4, 2025 election.
