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7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with 460**
8 **Tech, LLC. dba BeInCourt, as a Best Practical Source, to provide annual maintenance with**
9 **on-site support, for the Criminal Justice Virtual Courtroom Project, for a one-year term,**
10 **from 7/1/25 through 6/30/26, for an amount not to exceed \$330,731.42 for the first year, with**
11 **four options to renew for an additional one-year term, for the Executive's Department of**
12 **Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-358, which approved a
15 professional service contract with ExhibitOne Corp., to provide hardware and software to support
16 county-wide virtual courtroom proceedings for criminal justice stakeholders throughout Summit
17 County; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2023-039, which approved
20 a purchase contract with 460 Tech, LLC dba BeInCourt ("BeInCourt"), to provide one year of
21 maintenance on hardware and software for the county-wide virtual courtroom project, for the term
22 of 7/1/23 through 6/30/24; and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2024-211, which approved
25 a purchase contract with BeInCourt, to provide one year of maintenance on hardware and software
26 for the county-wide for the Criminal Justice Virtual Courtroom Project (the "Project"), for the
27 term of 7/1/24 through 6/30/25; and

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29 WHEREAS, this purchase contract includes the hardware and software that was installed
30 as part of the Project and includes on-site support, for the term of 7/1/25 through 6/30/26, for a
31 total cost not to exceed \$330,731.42 for the first year, with four options to renew for an additional
32 one-year term; and

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34 WHEREAS, BeInCourt is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and
35 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit because the maintenance
36 services provided are for a proprietary system already being utilized for the Project since its
37 inception; and

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39 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Board, at its meeting held on May 8, 2025,
40 approved the aforementioned purchase contract with BeInCourt; and

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42 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting to be held on May 14, 2025, approved the
43 aforementioned purchase contract with BeInCourt; and

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45 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
46 that the aforementioned purchase contract with BeInCourt is necessary and in the best interest of
47 the County of Summit;

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49 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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6 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with 460 Tech, LLC. dba
7 BeInCourt, to provide annual maintenance with on-site support, for the Criminal Justice Virtual
8 Courtroom Project (the "Project"), for the term of 7/1/25 through 6/30/26, for a total cost not to
9 exceed \$330,731.42 for the first year, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term,
10 is hereby approved and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and
11 any other necessary related documents.

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15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and
16 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
17 continue support of the Project.

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
22 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and
23 be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
28 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
30 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
