A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with the Community Drug Board, Inc. dba CHC Addiction Services, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing services, from 11/1/23 through 1/31/25, in an amount not to exceed \$88,030.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation Department, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation Department (the "Court") has used Community Drug Board, Inc. dba CHC Addiction Services, Inc. ("CHC") to drug test adult probationers for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2023-288, which approved a contract with CHC, as a Best Practical Source, to provide drug screens to adult probationers; and

WHEREAS, in addition to their lengthy relationship with the Court, CHC is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit because CHC provides the most extensive and observed drug testing in Summit County as well as providing convenient location and hours for easy access by probationers; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on May 21, 2025, approved a purchase contract with the CHC, as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing services, for serviced rendered from 11/1/23 through 1/31/25, in an amount not to exceed \$88,030.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned purchase contract with CHC is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with the Community Drug Board, Inc. dba CHC Addiction Services, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing services, from 11/1/23 through 1/31/25, in an amount not to exceed \$88,030.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide necessary drug screen testing services for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation Department.
