A Resolution authorizing the Executive to advertise for bids for the Summit County Jail Windows Project, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$369,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services—Physical Plants, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the existing windows are all original to the Jail from when it was constructed in 1987 and expanded in 1993; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Jail Windows Project (the "Project") will repair, caulk, seal and paint all the windows in the Jail giving them longevity into the future and provide proper building conditions for the inmates and staff at the Jail; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit requires this Council's authorization for the Executive to advertise for bids; and

WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the aforementioned Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$369,000.00; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's Office; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to advertise for bids for the Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$369,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the Summit County Jail Windows Project, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, in an amount not to exceed \$369,000.00.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the Executive to immediately provide for the necessary upgrades to the HVAC and plumbing systems at the Jail.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
9 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
