A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts with various providers of delinquent care and custody grant services as listed in Exhibit A, for the period 7/1/25 through 6/30/26, in a total amount not to exceed \$644,250.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division has received a State Fiscal Year 2026 Ohio Department of Youth Services Delinquent Care & Custody ("DC&C") grant, in the amount of \$644,250.00, for the period 7/1/25 through 6/30/26; and

WHEREAS, the DC&C grant allows local courts to develop or purchase a range of community based services to meet the needs of juvenile offenders or youth at risk of offending; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 28, 2025, awarded professional service contracts with various providers, a complete listing of including the contract amounts is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, for delinquent care and custody grant services, which as grant contracts and pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(12) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit are exempt from competitive bidding, for the period 7/1/25 through 6/30/26, in a total amount not to exceed \$644,250.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional service contracts with various providers are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts with various providers for delinquent care and custody grant services, as set forth in Exhibit A, which is attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully restated, for the period 7/1/25 through 6/30/26, in a total amount not to exceed \$644,250.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute the aforementioned professional service contracts and any necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for delinquent care and custody grant services effective 7/1/25.
