7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**  
8 **Insight Public Sector Inc., at less than State Term Pricing, for asset refreshes of computer**  
9 **equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$301,992.18, for the Office of Information**  
10 **Technology, and declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, the Office of Information Technology periodically undertakes equipment  
13 refreshes and is currently planning to refresh laptop and desktop computers to accommodate the  
14 needs for devices used by the Fiscal Office, the Executive's Department of Administrative  
15 Services-Physical Plants, and at the Jail; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, the Office of Information Technology recommends asset refreshes for 136  
18 Thinkpad T16 G3 laptops that are less than STS 534482 and for 199 Desktop TC M70Q Gen5  
19 and 18 Lenovo ThinkPad Universal USB-C docking stations that are less than STS 534411 to  
20 maximize the value, performance, and security of County assets over their lifespan; and

22 WHEREAS, this contract is exempt from competitive bidding under Section 177.07(a)(7)  
23 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit as the cost is less than State Term Pricing;  
24 and

26 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Board, at its meeting to be held on June 12,  
27 2025, approved the aforementioned contract for approval; and

29 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on June 18, 2025, awarded a  
30 purchase contract, approved by the Information Technology Board, with Insight Public Sector  
31 Inc., at less than State Term Pricing, for asset refreshes of computer equipment, in an amount not  
32 to exceed \$301,992.18, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

34 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
35 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Insight Public Sector Inc. is necessary and in the  
36 best interest of the County of Summit;

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38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

43 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Insight Public Sector Inc.,  
44 at less than State Term Pricing, for asset refreshes of computer equipment, in an amount not to  
45 exceed \$301,992.18, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said  
46 purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

50 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
51 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately  
52 providing necessary equipment refreshes for the Office of Information Technology.
