A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Palmer Engineering Company for the preliminary design of the Norwood Lake Outlet Stormwater Improvements Project, located in Northfield Center Township, in Council District 1, in amount not to exceed \$88,689.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Engineer intends to proceed with the Norwood Lake Outlet Stormwater Improvements Project (the "Project") to clean, remove obstructions from, restore, reconstruct and repair the drainage system discharging from Norwood Lake through the Norwood Development and connecting with the drainage infrastructure in the Route 82 right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2024-087, which authorized a viewing of the proposed improvements and set a public hearing pursuant to Section 6131.07 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2024-329, which authorized the Executive and Engineer to solicit proposals for the preparation of plans, surveys, and preliminary design of the Project as provided in Sections 6131.12, 6131.14, and 6131.15 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

 WHEREAS, the Engineer requested proposals from five firms and received qualifications from two firms with Palmer Engineering Company scoring the highest and the Engineer has negotiated the scope of the project and fee. As such, the Executive recommends selecting Palmer Engineering Company as the highest scoring and most qualified firm; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on July 16, 2025, awarded a professional service contract with Palmer Engineering Company for the preliminary design of the Norwood Lake Outlet Stormwater Improvements Project, located in Northfield Center Township, in Council District 1, in amount not to exceed \$88,689.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned professional service contract with Palmer Engineering Company is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1
