A Resolution authorizing the Executive to apply for and execute a loan agreement with the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund, for an additional amount of \$1,000,000.00 for a total amount not to exceed \$8,000,000.00, to fund Project Q-183 Pump Station No. 6 Replacement, located in the Cities of Hudson and Stow, in Council District 3, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to construct a replacement for Pump Station No. 6, located in the City of Hudson, that has incurred numerous failures due to age and upgrade Pump Station No. 13, located in the City of Stow, to manifold its force main into the Pump Station No. 6 force main to increase the pumping capacity at Pump Station No. 6 for Project Q-183 Pump Station No. 6 Replacement ("Project Q-183") in Council District 3; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution Nos. 2015-508, 2017-295 and 2017-482 that authorized the County to execute and appropriate funds for a professional service contract with CT Consultants Inc. for engineering design services for Project Q-183; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2022-050 that authorized the Executive to advertise for bids and previously adopted Resolution No. 2022-093 that authorized the Executive to apply for a loan with the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund, however, construction and funding did not commence for the project; and

 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2024-310 that authorized the Executive to advertise for bids for construction of Project Q-183 and apply for and execute a loan agreement with the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF"), with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("OEPA") and the Ohio Water Development Authority ("OWDA"), in an amount not to exceed \$7,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to obtain additional WPCLF loan funding in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 that is in addition to the original \$7,000,000.00 amount, as authorized by Resolution No. 2024-310, for a total amount not to exceed \$8,000,000.00; therefore, the County intends to apply for a loan with the WPCLF to fund Project Q-183, for a 20 year loan term, in an amount not to exceed \$8,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the WPCLF requires the legislative authority of the County to adopt legislation for the application of loans, the execution of agreements and the designation of repayment sources; and

 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to apply for and execute a loan agreement with the WPCLF with the OEPA and the OWDA for Project Q-183 in an amount not to exceed \$8,000,000.00 and designate repayment from the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund;
