7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (third and final)**
8 **of a purchase contract with Nesco Resource, LLC fka Callos Resource LLC, for payroll**
9 **services for the period 10/1/25 through 9/30/26, for various youth and adult employment**
10 **programs, including summer youth and year-round programs, in an amount not to exceed**
11 **\$2,900,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring**
12 **an emergency.**

13
14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2022-145, which authorized
15 the Executive to advertise for bids for payroll services for youth employment programs, for an
16 estimated total cost not to exceed \$1,400,000.00; and

17
18 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2022-297, which
19 authorized the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Nesco Resource, LLC
20 fka Callos Resource LLC, for payroll services for the period 10/1/22 through 9/30/23, for various
21 youth employment programs, including summer youth and year-round programs, with three
22 options to renew for additional one-year terms, in an amount not to exceed \$1,395,683.95; and

24 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2023-236, which
25 authorized the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of three) of a purchase contract
26 with Nesco Resource, LLC fka Callos Resource LLC, for payroll services for the period 10/1/23
27 through 9/30/24, for various youth employment programs, including summer youth and year-
28 round programs, in an amount not to exceed \$1,395,638.10; and

29
30 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2024-234, which
31 authorized the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of three) of a purchase
32 contract with Nesco Resource, LLC fka Callos Resource LLC, for payroll services for the period
33 10/1/24 through 9/30/25, for various youth employment programs, including summer youth and
34 year-round programs, in an amount not to exceed \$2,895,638.10; and

35
36 WHEREAS, the renewal is in the amount not to exceed \$2,900,000.00, provided by
37 Nesco Resource, LLC fka Callos Resource LLC and the Executive's Department of Job and
38 Family Services ("DJFS") seeks to renew its agreement with Summit and Medina Workforce
39 Area Council of Governments ("SAMWA COG") and Nesco Resource, LLC fka Callos
40 Resource to provide the aforementioned payroll services with administrative costs estimated at
41 \$65,921.46 and \$2,834,078.54 in passthrough funds for youth and adult payroll including wages,
42 incentives, payroll taxes and workers' compensation costs; and

43
44 WHEREAS, by having one payroll service provider, the burden of meeting payroll and
45 carrying workers' compensation coverage is alleviated for non-profits and employer sites for
46 these temporary employees; and

47
48 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio recognizes this method as a cost effective manner to
49 handle issuance of pay (youth wage subsidies) and workers' compensation liability; and

4 WHEREAS, under this agreement, DJFS and SAMWA COG act as “grantors” of
5 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (“WIOA”) and Temporary Assistance to Needy
6 Families (“TANF”) funding for the provision of these services; and
7

8 WHEREAS, the overall cost of said payroll services for this renewal is based on the
9 various employment programs enrolling up to 700 local youth; and
10

11 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 3, 2025, awarded a
12 renewal (third and final) of a purchase contract with Nesco Resource, LLC fka Callos Resource,
13 for payroll services for the period 10/1/25 through 9/30/26, for various youth and adult
14 employment programs, including summer youth and year-round programs, in an amount not to
15 exceed \$2,900,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and
16

17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
18 that the aforementioned renewal of a purchase contract with Nesco Resource, LLC fka Callos
19 Resource is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

24 SECTION 1

25
26 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (third and final) of a purchase contract
27 with Nesco Resource, LLC fka Callos Resource, for payroll services for the period 10/1/25
28 through 9/30/26, for various youth and adult employment programs, including summer youth and
29 year-round programs, in an amount not to exceed \$2,900,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the
30 Executive is hereby authorized to execute said renewal and any other necessary related
31 documents.

33 SECTION 2

35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and
36 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to
37 immediately provide required payroll services for various youth and adult employment
38 programs.

40 SECTION 3

42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

46 SECTION 4

48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
51 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including
52 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
