The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, with Cardinal Environmental Services, Inc., an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, for lead-based paint removal for the Ohio Building Project, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, in an amount not to exceed \$143,640.00, and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the Executive to immediately proceed with necessary improvements to the Ohio Building.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
