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WHEREAS, this Council wishes to fix a date for the filing of a final report, plans, and the construction schedules for the proposed improvement as provided in Sections 6131.12, 6131.14, and 6131.15 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## **SECTION 1**

 This Council finds that the Engineer's preliminary report substantially complies with the requirements of Section 6131.09 of the Ohio Revised Code providing (1) a preliminary estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; (2) comments on the feasibility of the project; (3) a statement of the engineer's opinion as to whether benefits from the project are likely to exceed the estimated cost; and (4) a list of factors apparent to the engineer, both favorable and unfavorable to the proposed improvement. The Petitioner and others have been informed of the contents of the preliminary report.

## **SECTION 2**

This Council, based on the preliminary report, and hearing any evidence offered by any owner for or against the granting of the proposed improvement, finds and is of the opinion that the improvement is necessary, will be conducive to the public welfare, and that it is reasonably certain that the benefits outweigh the costs of the improvement. Therefore, the preparation of project survey and plans for the Dorwick Ditch based on the route and termini identified in the Engineer's preliminary report shall proceed as provided in Section 6131.12 of the Ohio Revised Code. The Summit County Engineer will prepare the final reports, plans, and schedules as provided in Chapter 6131 of the Ohio Revised Code. Such reports, plans, and schedules shall be filed with this Council by March 31, 2026.

## **SECTION 3**

 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately order the filing of a final report, plans, and schedules for a proposed public improvement located in Northfield Center Township, Summit County, Ohio.

## **SECTION 4**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
