A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Hamco X-Ray Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for three X-Ray scanners, for the use of two at the Common Pleas Courthouse and one at the Juvenile Court Facility, in an amount not to exceed \$136,575.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the current Court X-ray scanners are old, outdated machines passed their useful service lives and for which replacement parts are no longer available; and

WHEREAS, to maintain and improve Court security and safety, the Sheriff wishes to purchase three Smith's Detection HS 6040C X-Ray Scanners, for the use of two at the Common Pleas Courthouse and one at the Juvenile Court Facility; and

WHEREAS, this purchase contract includes all accessories, parts, shipping, installation and in-house training on the scanners and a one-year warranty from the date of installation; and

WHEREAS, Hamco X-Ray Inc. is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit because in addition to being extremely familiar with County facilities including the Common Pleas Courthouse and Jail, they are the only supplier and repair company based in Ohio with available staff to come to the County to install the scanners and train the Sheriff's staff to use them; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 16, 2025, awarded a purchase contract with Hamco X-Ray Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for three Smith's Detection HS 6040C X-Ray Scanners for the use of two at the Common Pleas Courthouse and one at the Juvenile Court Facility, in an amount not to exceed \$136,575.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned purchase contract with Hamco X-Ray Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Hamco X-Ray Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for three Smith's Detection HS 6040C X-Ray Scanners for the use of two at the Common Pleas Courthouse and one at the Juvenile Court Facility, in an amount not to exceed \$136,575.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any necessary related documents.

20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

23 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
