7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with The Drala Project, Inc., dba The Redesign Group, under the National**
9 **Cooperative Purchasing Alliance, for storage as a service, for a three-year term, in an**
10 **amount not to exceed \$208,251.00, for the Office of Information Technology, and declaring**
11 **an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Office of Information Technology previously identified a need to
14 replace the County's current primary backup storage device; and

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16 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2024-326, which confirmed
17 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with The Drala Project, Inc.,
18 dba The Redesign Group, under the National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance, for storage as a
19 service, for a three-year term, in an amount not to exceed \$225,000.00; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Office of Information Technology has determined that it is necessary to
22 purchase additional backup storage services; and

24 WHEREAS, the professional service contract with The Drala Project, Inc., dba The
25 Redesign Group is exempt from competitive bidding pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(11) of the
26 Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit under the National Cooperative Purchasing
27 Alliance; and

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29 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 1, 2025, awarded a
30 professional service contract with The Drala Project, Inc., dba The Redesign Group, under the
31 National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance, for storage as a service to replace the current primary
32 backup storage device, for a three-year term, in an amount not to exceed \$208,251.00, subject to
33 confirmation by this Council; and

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35 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Board, at its meeting held on October 9, 2025,
36 approved the aforementioned professional service contract; and

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38 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
39 that the aforementioned professional service contract with The Drala Project, Inc., dba The
40 Redesign Group is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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47 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract, approved by the
48 Information Technology Board on October 9, 2025, with The Drala Project, Inc., dba The
49 Redesign Group, under the National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance, for storage as a service to
50 replace the current primary backup storage device, for a three-year term, in an amount not to
51 exceed \$208,251.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
52 professional service contract and any other necessary related documents.
