7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Teletronics Services, Inc. (TTX), as a Best Practical Source, for hardware**
9 **replacement services, in an amount not to exceed \$105,186.33, for the Office of Information**
10 **Technology, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, previously, the Office of Information Technology solicited proposals and
13 Teletronics Services, Inc. (TTX) scored the highest of two submitted proposals using such
14 criteria as demonstrated ability, quality of proposal, and cost; and

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16 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2024-327, which confirmed
17 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Teletronics Services,
18 Inc. (TTX), for SCALE servers hardware and licensing, in an amount not to exceed \$197,293.86;
19 and

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21 WHEREAS, due to the success of the previous project of deploying hardware in 2025,
22 the Office of Information Technology wishes to utilize Teletronics Services, Inc. (TTX) for
23 additional hardware replacement; and

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25 WHEREAS, the County wishes to enter into a professional services contract with
26 Teletronics Services, Inc. (TTX), hardware replacement services, in an amount not to exceed
27 \$105,186.33; and

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29 WHEREAS, Teletronics Services, Inc. (TTX) is a best practical source pursuant to
30 Sections 177.01(h)(4)(D) and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
31 due to their ongoing experience on the current project and their unique knowledge of the
32 County's environment; and

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34 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on October 1, 2025, awarded,
35 subject to approval by the Information Technology Board, the aforementioned professional
36 service contract, as a Best Practical Source, with Teletronics Services, Inc. (TTX), in a total
37 amount not to exceed \$105,186.33, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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39 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Board, at its meeting held on October 9, 2025,
40 approved the aforementioned professional service contract; and

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42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
43 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Teletronics Services, Inc. (TTX) is
44 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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6 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract, approved by the
7 Information Technology Board on October 9, 2025, with Teletronics Services, Inc. (TTX), as a
8 Best Practical Source, for hardware replacement services, in an amount not to exceed
9 \$105,186.33, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
10 professional service contract and any other necessary related documents.

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12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
16 authorize necessary hardware replacement services.

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
