A Resolution approving the vacation of a portion of Wyoga Lake Road, located in Boston Township, in Council District 1, for Council, pursuant to Chapter 5553 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 125.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, for the Council, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Engineer has recommended that a portion of Wyoga Lake Road, located in Boston Township, as described in Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein, be vacated pursuant to Chapter 5553 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 125.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 125.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and Section 5553.05 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Clerk of this Council caused notice to be delivered by regular mail to the Ohio Director of Natural Resources and Boston Township informing those parties of the date set for the public viewing and hearings, and complied with all public notice requirements as set forth in Section 5553.05 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 125.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, the owners of property adjacent to and abutting the portion of roadway to be vacated waived notice of the viewing and hearing, and have agreed to the division of land as set forth in the vacation plat attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2025-239, as required by Section 125.03(e) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and Section 5553.05 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council conducted a public viewing of the area proposed to be vacated on October 7, 2025; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2025-239, as required by Section 125.03(e) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and Section 5553.05 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council held a public hearing on the proposal to vacate on October 20, 2025; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 5553.06 and 5553.07, the Engineer has prepared a report on the proposed vacation and said report was submitted to Council and made a part of the record of the public hearing on October 16, 2025; and

WHEREAS, a legal description and vacation plat of the portions of Wyoga Lake Road proposed to be vacated has been prepared and is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that (i) this Council has complied with all legal requirements, including but not limited to, those contained in Chapter 5553 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 125.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, and (ii) the vacation of those portions of Wyoga Lake Road set forth in the legal description and vacation plat attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein is for the public convenience and welfare, and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The vacation of that portion of Wyoga Lake Road located in Boston Townships in Council District 1 set forth in the legal description and vacation plat attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, is hereby approved and the same is hereby vacated, and the vacated land hereby vests in the abutting land owners as shown on the vacation plat, subject to the preservation of any existing right-of-way by any public utility in, over or under the vacated land, together with ingress and egress thereto and therefrom for the purpose of serving and maintaining the same. Further, the Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to complete the vacation of those portions of Wyoga Lake Road.

SECTION 2

The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to file a copy of this Resolution, the legal description and vacation plat attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, and any other record of the proceedings with the Fiscal Officer for tax purposes, and with the Engineer for road purposes.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
