DATE October 27, 2025 COMMITTEE Rules

An Ordinance amending Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit entitled “Compensation,” to adjust compensation for supervisors of the Department of Sanitary Sewer Services during on-call duty, for the Executive’s Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2015-217, that amended Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit which sets forth the on-call duty pay for supervisory employees with the Executive’s Department of Sanitary Sewer Services (“DSSS”) when the employees are on-call and required to respond to situations such as equipment failure or severe weather outside their regularly scheduled workday; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Section 169.07 to set forth the payment adjustment for the weekday on-call duty payments and to add payment rates for weekend on-call duty and holiday on-call duty payments for the DSSS supervisors; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of County of Summit to amend Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated, for the reasons set forth above;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled “Compensation,” is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose of immediately amending the aforementioned section to provide Department of Sanitary Sewer Services supervisors prompt and appropriate compensation.

SECTION 3

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
