Section 2151, between Summit County Children Services, all Municipal Police Departments, and the County of Summit, including 9 the Executive's Department of Job & Family Services, the Sheriff's Office, the Prosecutor's 10 11 Office, the Juvenile Court, and authorizing the Executive to execute the MOU and other 12 necessary documents, and declaring an emergency. 13 14 WHEREAS, sections 2151.4220, 2151.4221, 2151.4222, 2151.4225, 2151.4226, 2151.4230, and 2151.4234 of the Ohio Revised Code and section 5180:2-33-26 of the Ohio 15 Administrative Code require various County agencies to execute a Memorandum of 16 17 Understanding (MOU) to address child abuse and neglect investigations; and 18 19 WHEREAS, said MOU is an agreement between community partners to coordinate 20 screening, assessment and investigation, and service provision for child abuse and neglect 21 investigations and to outline the roles and responsibilities of each participating agency; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the MOU is signed bi-annually by the parties, including the County of 24 Summit, Summit County Children Services, and all Municipal Police Departments; and 25 26 WHEREAS, in 2022 the Ohio General Assembly amended section 2151 to include 27 2151.4222 and 2151.4225 which require that the MOU be submitted to the Board of County 28 Commissioners for approval, therefore requiring approval by this Council and the Executive; and 29 30 WHEREAS, after all parties have signed said MOU, the County is required to post a 31 copy on the general county website, and the MOU will be effective the date of posting; and 32 33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, 34 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to approve the above referenced 35 Memorandum of Understanding; 36 37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State 38 of Ohio, that: 39 40 **SECTION 1** 41 42 The County hereby approves the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the County of Summit and various community partners and authorizes the Executive to execute the 43 44 MOU and any other necessary documents required to finalize the MOU. 45 46 **SECTION 2** 47

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and

welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately

authorizing the MOU to address child abuse and neglect investigation and to post the finalized

MOU on the County's website as required by the Ohio Revised Code.
