## **SECTION 1**

 The award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental purchase contract with the City of Fairlawn on behalf of FairlawnGig, as a Best Practical Source, for high speed internet service to support the virtual court project, for a one-year term, for the period from 1/1/26 to 12/31/26, in a total amount not to exceed \$120,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any related necessary documents.
