7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement with**
8 **the City of Akron for the boarding at the Jail of misdemeanor offenders charged under a**
9 **City of Akron ordinance or charged with contempt of an Akron Municipal Court Judge,**
10 **for a one-year term, for the period of 1/1/26 through 12/31/26, in an amount not to exceed**
11 **\$2,976,300.00, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, since 1993, the County has boarded certain City of Akron offenders charged
14 with misdemeanor offenses under a City of Akron ordinance or charged with contempt of an
15 Akron Municipal Court Judge pursuant to an intergovernmental agreement with the City of
16 Akron; and

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18 WHEREAS, in 2025, this Council adopted Resolution No. 2025-005, which authorized
19 the Executive to execute a six-month intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron that
20 ended on June 30, 2025; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Executive and Sheriff have negotiated a new intergovernmental
23 agreement with the City of Akron for the boarding at the Jail of misdemeanor offenders charged
24 under a City of Akron ordinance or charged with contempt of an Akron Municipal Court Judge,
25 for a one-year term, for the period of 1/1/26 to 12/31/26, in an amount not to exceed
26 \$2,976,300.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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28 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
29 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
30 execute the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement;

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32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
33 of Ohio, that:

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35 SECTION 1

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37 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the
38 City of Akron for the boarding at the Jail of misdemeanor offenders charged under a City of
39 Akron ordinance or charged with contempt of an Akron Municipal Court Judge, for a one-year
40 term, for the period of 1/1/26 through 12/31/26, in an amount not to exceed \$2,976,300.00, with
41 such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said agreement,
42 and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the
43 execution thereof by the Executive.

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45 SECTION 2

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47 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
48 welfare of the residents of Summit County, and for the further reason to immediately authorize
49 the boarding of the aforementioned offenders pursuant to the aforementioned intergovernmental
50 agreement.

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4 SECTION 3

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6 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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10 SECTION 4

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12 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
13 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
14 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
15 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
